Golf with other women in a non-threatening environment



The desire to improve her game while making new friends in a casual setting, and not have it break the bank, prompted Sassy Golf founder and owner Nancy Collins to develop the concept for a different kind of women's golf league—one that welcomed women of all levels and gave them opportunities to learn the game and have other women to golf with in a stress-free setting at half the cost. With an average of two-three weekly 9-hole rounds that always includes a golf lesson, golf cart, and beverage of their choice, women can come and play golf after work and on the weekends when it makes the most sense for them.

"Why wait until you retire to learn or improve your golf game because you don't have the time, money, or friends to golf with. With an average of 20 players at each event, and at over half the cost of what it would cost someone to do it on their own, it's a no-brainer! We're all about fun, friendship, variety, and stress-free golf outings at public and private courses around the Denver Metro area for cheap," said Nancy. "We have no hassles, no rules, no handicaps, just lots of great golf events for women of all ages, career women and moms

whose busy lives can't be tied down to rigid requirements."

Sassy Golf's unique "play and pay as you go" membership structure takes the pressure off members to adhere to schedules. The league offers weekly golf outings, clinics, and equipment demos that members can book when they can find time in their solidly booked calendars. There is no requirement to play a certain number of games each year. Members simply come and play as their schedules permit, so they never lose money by missing an event. And unlike conventional leagues, Sassy Golf will schedule events on all different afternoons each week, giving members a chance to improve their skills in a wide variety of courses and days. Collins giggles, "I can't believe or be happier that we're about to begin our fourth season and everyone is still cheering Sassy Golf on. I have to pinch myself because I'm still just a girl who wants to golf, learn as I go, while having fun doing it!
